

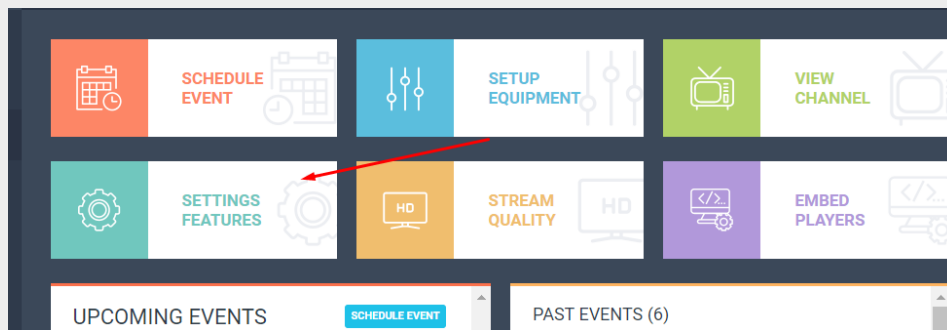

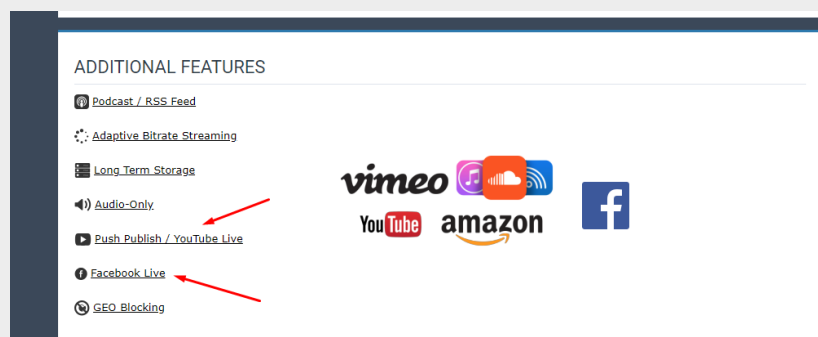
## Social Media Streaming Regs Changed

New changes to Facebook's streaming video policy means greater flexibility and opportunity for clients to extend their live events across multiple channels. Facebook has lifted the restriction that prevented Churches from streaming to FB Live but not to other social media platforms. While in place, you could choose to stream to Facebook Live but not other live channels like YouTube or Twitch using the API integration of the ChurchStreaming platform. Now, you can configure your social media accounts through our dashboard to allow for simultaneous live streaming.

Here's what you need to do. First, log in to your ChurchStreaming client dashboard. Once logged in, look for the settings/features button –



When you click on that button, it will take you to the settings/features page. Scroll to the bottom of the page and you'll see the section for additional features. Here is where you will configure your specific social media channels. Facebook has its own selection, YouTube/Twitter/Twitch are all under the Push Publish/YouTube Live selection.



If you are configuring the YouTube Live channel or Twitter or Twitch, you must first select yes on the destinations. Then you will enter the information required to allow streaming. If you're unsure how to set up live streaming through YouTube, [CLICK HERE](#) for a step by step guide.

**YOUTUBE CONFIGURATION**

To stream to your YouTube live account:


1. Login to your YouTube account and click on *Live Streaming* along the left side.  
  
Note: If you can't see *Live Streaming* on the left side, click your name on the top right and then press the *Creator Studio* button under your name. Once the page is refreshed you should see the *Live Streaming* along the left side.
2. From the *Encoder Setup* (at the bottom) enter the YouTube Server URL and Stream Name Key in the fields below and press the *Configure Push Publish* button.  
  
Server URL:   
*example: rtmp://a.rtmp.youtube.com/live2*
- Stream name/key:   
*example: fqa6-x99t-89z1-4er7*

3. Press *Save Changes*. All of your live streams will be automatically published to YouTube Live.

To set up Facebook Live as a destination, you must first log in to your FB account through the ChurchStreaming dashboard.
